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HVS 5a – 200m. Excellent rock.

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The route starts at the very foot of the face, on a huge boulder with a ridge in its middle. It's possible to reach the start of pitch 2 by the right of the boulder.

P1 : 30m – 4b

Start on the right side of the ridge and follow it all way long.

P2 : 30m – 4c

Move the belay up and right at the foot of the next wall. Start a bit on the left in broken looking rock (but excellent...), reach a flake and then follow a small crack on the left of the flake. Belay on big terrasse.

P3 : 40m – 5a

Start on the left of the terrasse, in the axe of a small roof situated 15m above. Climb a nice but poorly protected wall to reach the roof, go left for 3m and climb a steep bulge, belay on a big ledge at the foot of a steep dihedral.

P4 : 40m – 4c

Start in the dihedral for a few meters, once it's possible to go left to reach a flake, go on and then climb the nice slab above going gently left. Belay on a small ledge, under and left of a wide crack.

P5 : 25m – 4b

Climb the steep step just above the belay then easier to reach a small dihedral on the right with a palm tree at its foot, follow it to the summit.
